

HOW TO IDENTIFY THE STANDARD

- ‘KNOW YOUR STANDARDS’
- Once Standard is identified, Scope of the Standard defines its coverage
- All Indian Standards (ISs) are Downloadable Free of Cost

VARIOUS CERTIFICATION SCHEMES

Scheme	Scope of the Scheme
Scheme- I ()	Grant of licence to use or apply Standard Mark on products as per Indian Standard
Scheme – II ()	Grant of licence to use or apply Standard Mark through registration based on self-declaration of conformity for goods and articles as per Indian Standard
Scheme - III	Grant of licence or certificate of conformity for management systems as per Indian standard e.g. Quality Management Systems (IS/ISO 9001), Environmental Management Systems (IS/ISO 14001), Anti Bribery Management Systems (IS/ISO 37001)

HOW BIS ENSURES PRODUCT QUALITY

- Initial attestation:
 - Production process & testing capability assessment
 - Product conformity - Independent test report
- Validity
 - Initial attestation - 1 to 2 years
 - Renewal - 1 to 5 years
- Surveillance
 - Periodic assessment
 - Factory and market surveillance
- Licence to use Standard Mark ()

BIS Certification Process, SIMPLIFIED

- ManakOnline IT portal – Complete digitisation
 - Desk assessment- Missing information (if any) asked in consolidated manner
 - No physical file and paper documents
- Strict timelines for processes involved
 - Desk assessment findings informed to manufacturer in 5 working days
 - Inspection visit within 10 days
- Majority of products brought under simplified procedure
 - Grant of certification within 30 days

INITIATIVES TOWARDS EFFECTIVE QCO IMPLEMENTATION

- Concession in Marking Fees for SMEs
- Sharing of testing facilities ; Utilization of cluster based testing facilities by MSME`s
- Product Manual as a Guidance Document
- Relaxation in the requirement of having a fully equipped laboratory for MSMEs for the purpose of conformity assessment
- Manufacturers are free to define their own Levels of Controls
- Simplification of procedures for Conformity Assessment
